SECTION 2

Essay 1

This is your chance to tell us why you are a good applicant for a scholarship, how you will stand out in your studies and what you believe will be the benefits of studying at CWU to your future.

Please write statements for all three criteria. You should write approximately 300 words for each section.

The scholarship committee reserve the right not to consider any applications that include statements exceeding the recommended word limit or are significantly below this or are incomplete.

The scholarship committee will be looking for any evidence and experience that emphasizes your strengths and qualities and makes your application more noticeable than others.

Please make sure your statements are original. You must not copy your personal statement from the internet, or your scholarship application will not be considered.

Essay 2

What skills and life experiences make you a good candidate for a scholarship?

Please tell us how your experiences will make you an excellent student both socially and academically and the impact you may have on the University and its student community. You may also want to tell us what qualities, skills, and experiences you will bring to your course and the University.

Please write approximately 300 words for this section.

Essay 3

Academic excellence and potential for academic excellence

Please demonstrate your history of academic excellence and your potential for academic excellence.

Please give examples from your previous studies and experience and show how these will help you excel in your chosen program in CWU.

Please include some of the following or other examples:

- Results from your qualifications, including individual module results which are particularly relevant for your chosen course at CWU;
- Prizes and awards you have received;
- Presentations you have given including conference or school presentations;
- Achievements beyond education (work, other life experiences) which you feel show your ability to reach your full potential on your program.

Please write approximately 300 words for this section.

Essay 4

The benefits of studying at CWU? Please show how you believe studying at CWU and your chosen program will benefit you and help you in your career objectives. Please show how the knowledge and skills you will learn will benefit future employers and the wider society.

Please include some of the following or other examples:

- Your future career plans and goals including the type of business or organization you would like to work for;
- The specific ways that gaining this University qualification will contribute to achieving these career plans;
- How the knowledge and skills you will learn will benefit future employers;
- How studying here will help you have a positive impact on humanity.

Terms and conditions

Please confirm that you have read the scholarship terms and conditions.

1. To be eligible for consideration for an international scholarship, applicants must: (a) have conditional acceptance letter, and (b) be classed as an overseas student for tuition fee purposes.
2. Students who are sponsored (ie. fees are being paid) by their employers, government, or a funding body (full / part) are not eligible to apply for these scholarship awards.
3. Applicants are only eligible to apply for a scholarship if they are planning to enroll in the first year of their program in September 2020. Students due to enroll in the second, third, or fourth year of their course September 2020 or students repeating their first year of study are not eligible to apply.
4. Applicants must be a new international student starting a new program. We cannot consider applications from students who are currently studying at CWU unless progressing onto a new program.
5. The scholarships will be a tuition fee reduction. If you are awarded a scholarship, your fee will be adjusted before you enroll.
6. If you are granted any other scholarship, bursary, and / or fee reduction from the University the maximum amount granted will not exceed half the tuition fee, except candidates who are awarded a Fully funded Scholarship.
7. The scholarship is not transferable and will not be awarded if you choose to postpone your enrollment to a different start date, or if you choose to transfer to a different program at the University.
8. Applicants will be informed whether they have (or have not) been awarded a scholarship (and of the value of the scholarship award if they have been awarded) within four weeks of the application deadline dates.
9. The scholarship will be granted when an applicant accepts their scholarship offer, accepts and meets the conditions of their course offer, and are eligible to enroll on the course. ,

10. Scholarships are competitive and selection is based on the information provided on the scholarship application form. It is, therefore, of great importance that you give your scholarship statement careful thought and preparation, and that you refer to the criteria provided.
11. The University's decision in all matters relating to the scholarship is final.
12. If your scholarship application is successful, we may ask you to become a student ambassador or to appear in online and/or printed marketing materials for the University. For example, providing a student profile and a photograph which may be used to promote the University and the University's scholarship schemes and courses. Your name and program will be printed in the Scholarships Awards Celebration Program.
13. If a student fails to complete an eligible course that has received the scholarship and chooses to retake the course or undertake another eligible course, then the scholarship will not be applied again.
14. If a student fails to complete a course and the scholarship was not applied (i.e. the student did not pay the tuition fees, or the tuition fees were reimbursed) then subject to the eligibility criteria, the scholarship may be available should the student choose to retake the course or undertake another eligible course. Students must re-apply for the scholarship.
